A public meeting is planned for the near future to seek members, and support to complete the process for this key project in the community.

The group of interested retired men who have walked beside us over these past two years to get to trust level will now commence to work with council staff to secure an appropriate site for the build of the Men's Shed in the local area. The working group has been so patient as we move toward this next step, it has been a journey. The concept of The Men's Shed began in Australia and these have now expanded to New Zealand, a place where retired men, who find themselves without the space for a workshop in which to pursue their hobbies, trade or just be `doing something` for the community. Retired men have many skills that can be passed onto our younger generation, and the project will once operational will undertake a community support role in this area. Initially it is planned to provide a workshop for Woodwork, Engineering and Electronics and to expand to other areas as the need arises,. They are looking for donations of used equipment (working or not); nuts; bolts; screws; nails etc. which are no longer required.
